Hebrew Aleph Bet

These pages will show the Hebrew letter, and have a space for tracing the letter.

Basic Numbers (1-10)

The number pages will have the number in Hebrew and the numeric value in English. The English numeric value will have space to use stickers, paint dots, coloring, etc. Each page has the corresponding number of dots for additional counting practice.

Hebrew Colors

These pages will come with cards to print out and match, as well as space for tracing. I recommend using Velcro pieces to make it easier to attach the matching color cards.

Hebrew Shapes

These traceable pages will have a picture of the shape and the shape/s name in Hebrew.

Days of the Week

These pages will have a section for tracing the name of the day in Hebrew.

Months of the Hebraic Calendar

These pages will have traceable word cards for each month of the Hebraic calendar. It will also notate the corresponding months of the Gregorian calendar.

Weather

Beginners will learn basic weather in Hebrew.
