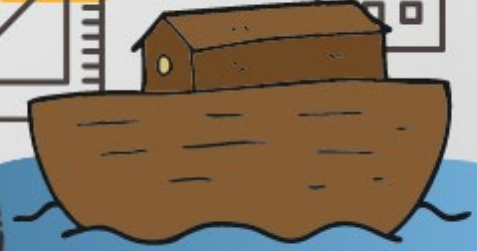

## Session 1 | Building a Family Vision

What is a family vision?

- How we see the future.
- What our family *could be* IF we had:
  - The right structure
  - The right leadership
  - Adequate funding
  - A group of people that believed in the same vision.
- Vision speaks to an organization's purpose and why it is important for the organization to exist.

God has a plan and purpose for *your* family.

Our response is to form His plan into a vision, based on His Word and His call for our lives.

Behold, children *are* a heritage from YHVH,  
The fruit of the womb *is* a reward.  
Like arrows in the hand of a warrior,  
So *are* the children of one's youth.  
Happy *is* the man who has his quiver full of them;  
They shall not be ashamed,  
But shall speak with their enemies in the gate (Psalm 127:3-5, NKJV).

Noah (Genesis 6)

- 120 years to complete it (Genesis 6:3)
- Had to develop skills

  - In addition, Noah was also a preacher of righteousness, calling men to repent (2 Peter 2:5).

Abraham (Genesis 18:16-19)

- Notice why YHVH gave Abraham a vision: He was faithful.
- Notice that YHVH gives a family vision to the \_\_\_\_\_, the leader of the family.

Family members are not to be independent of each other, but interdependent – part of the same team.

1 Corinthians 11:11

- Man is to leave his father and mother and cleave unto his wife (Genesis 2:24).
- Wife is to leave her father's house (and tribe) and join her husband's house (and tribe).
- She is his suitable helper (Genesis 2:18).
- Proverbs 31 woman – her husband was respected at the city gate, where he took his seat among the elders of the land (v. 23); her children and husband arose and called her blessed and praised her (v. 28).
- Both spouses are to make the other honorable in the eyes of their children (Exodus 20:12).
- Homes are to be full of respect, love, honor, cherishing, nourishment.
