A VISION FOR MY LIFE

YHVH your God will make you abound in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your land for good. For YHVH will again rejoice over you for good as He rejoiced over your fathers. (Deuteronomy 30:9)

For He repays man according to his work,
And makes man to find a reward according to his way. (Job 34:11)

But we urge you, brethren, that you increase more and more; that you also aspire to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you, that you may walk properly toward those who are outside, and that you may lack nothing. (1 Thessalonians 4:10-12)

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work. I charge you therefore before God and the Master Yeshua the Messiah, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom: Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. (2 Timothy 3:16-4:2)

Moreover, because I have set my affection on the house of my God, I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house, my own special treasure of gold and silver: three thousand talents of gold, of the gold of Ophir, and seven thousand talents of refined silver, to overlay the walls of the houses; the gold for things of gold and the silver for things of silver, and for all kinds of work to be done by the hands of craftsmen. Who then is willing to consecrate himself this day to YHVH? (1 Chronicles 25:3-5)

...well reported for good works: if she has brought up children, if she has lodged strangers, if she has washed the saints' feet, if she has relieved the afflicted, if she has diligently followed every good work. (1 Timothy 5:10)

Now all the work of Solomon was well-ordered from the day of the foundation of the house of YHVH until it was finished. So the house of YHVH was completed. (2 Chronicles 8:16)

And let the beauty of YHVH our God be upon us,
And establish the work of our hands for us;
Yes, establish the work of our hands. (Psalm 90:17)

But you, be strong and do not let your hands be weak, for your work shall be rewarded!" (2 Chronicles 15:7)

For God is not unjust to forget your work and labor of love which you have shown toward His name, in that you have ministered to the saints, and do minister. And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope until the end, that you do not become sluggish, but imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises. (Hebrews 6:10-12)

And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, in the law and in the commandment, to seek his God, he did it with all his heart. So he prospered. (2 Chronicles 31:21)

The work of righteousness will be peace, and the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever. (Isaiah 32:17)

For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of YHVH, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. (Colossians 1:9-12)

MORNING PRAYER

O come, let us bow down and bend the knee; let us kneel before YHVH our Maker (Psalm 95:6).

And YHVH commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear YHVH our Elohim, for our good always, that He might preserve us alive, as it is at this day. And it shall be righteousness unto us, if we observe to do all this commandment before YHVH our Elohim, as He hath commanded us (Deuteronomy 6:24-25). He declares His word to Jacob, His statutes and His ordinances to Israel. He has not dealt so with any nation; and as for His ordinances, they have not known them. HalleluYah (Psalm 147:19-20). Blessed be YHVH for evermore. Amen and amen (Psalm 89:53).

This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Yeshua the Messiah His Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us (1 John 1:5-10).

YHVH is near to all them that call upon Him, to all that call upon Him in truth. He will fulfill the desire of them that fear Him; He also will hear their cry, and will save them (Psalm 145:18-19). O You that hears prayers, unto You does all flesh come (Psalm 65:3). Happy are they that dwell in Your house; they are ever praising You. Selah (Psalm 84:5).

YHVH, YHVH God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children and the children's children to the third and the fourth generation (Exodus 34:6-7).

Take my prayer as an offering of incense, my upraised hands as an evening sacrifice. O YHVH, set a guard over my mouth, a watch at the door of my lips (Psalm 141:2-3). O YHVH, open my lips, and let my mouth declare Your praise (Psalm 51:17). My mouth shall utter the praise of YHVH, and all creatures shall bless His holy name forever and ever (Psalm 145:21).

O YHVH, hear my prayer, and let my cry come unto You (Psalm 102:2).

Hear, O Israel: YHVH is our Elohim, YHVH is one. And you shall love YHVH your Elohim with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. And these words, which I command you this day, shall be upon your heart; and you shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise up. And you shall bind them for a sign upon your hand, and they shall be a headband on your forehead. And you shall write them upon the doorposts of your house, and upon your gates (Deuteronomy 6:5-9).

And it shall come to pass, if you shall hearken diligently to My commandments which I command you this day, to love YHVH your Elohim, and to serve Him with all your heart and with all your soul, that I will give the rain of your land in its season, the former rain and the latter rain, that you may gather in your grain, and your wine, and your oil. And I will give grass in your fields for your cattle, and you shall eat and be satisfied. Be careful lest your heart be deceived, and you turn aside, and serve other gods, and bow down to them; and the anger of YHVH be kindled against you, and He shut up the heaven, so that there shall be no rain, and the ground shall not yield her fruit; and you perish quickly from off the good land which YHVH gives you.

Therefore shall you lay up these My words in your heart and in your soul; and you shall bind them for a sign upon your hand, and they shall be a headband upon your forehead. And you shall teach them to your children, talking of them, when you sit in your house, and when you lie down, and when you rise up. And you shall write them upon the doorposts of your house, and upon your gates; that your days may be multiplied, and the days of your children, upon the land which YHVH swore to your fathers to give them, as the days of the heavens above the earth (Deuteronomy 11:13-21).

And YHVH spoke to Moses, saying: "Speak unto the children of Israel, and command them that they make them throughout their generations tsitsit on the corners of their garments, and that they put with the tsitsit of each corner a thread of blue. And it shall be to you for tsitsit, that you may look upon it, and remember all the commandments of YHVH, and do them; and that you go not about after your own heart and your own eyes, after which you used to go astray; that you may remember and do all My commandments, and be holy to your Elohim. I am YHVH your Elohim, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your Elohim: I am YHVH your Elohim" (Numbers 15:37-41).

But YHVH is the true Elohim, He is the living Elohim, and the everlasting King; at His wrath the earth trembles, and the nations are not able to abide His indignation (Jeremiah 10:10). And take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth; for I hope in Your ordinances (Psalm 119:43). And YHVH shall be King over all the earth; in that day shall YHVH be one, and His name one (Zechariah 14:9). YHVH will reign forever, your Elohim, O Zion, unto all generations. HalleluYah (Psalm 146:10). Your kingdom is a kingdom for all ages, and Your dominion endures throughout all generations (Psalm 145:13). For the kingdom is YHVH's; and He is the ruler over the nations (Psalm 22:29). YHVH is king; YHVH has always been king (N.B.). YHVH shall reign forever and ever (Exodus 15:18). Blessed be YHVH for evermore. Amen and amen (Psalm 89:53).

O YHVH, save Your people, the remnant of Israel (Jeremiah 31:7). Save Your people, and bless Your inheritance; and tend them, and carry them forever (Psalm 28:9). Blessed be YHVH for evermore. Amen and amen (Psalm 89:53).

All Your works shall praise You, O YHVH; and Your righteous ones shall bless You (Psalm 145:10).

Blessed be You, O YHVH, the Elohim of Israel our father, forever and ever. Yours, O YHVH, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty; for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O YHVH, and You are exalted as head above all. Both riches and honor come from You, and You rule over all; and in Your hand is power and might; and in Your hand is the power to make great, and to give strength to all. Now therefore, our Elohim, we thank You, and praise Your glorious name (1 Chronicles 29:10-13). But we will bless YHVH from this time forth and forever. HalleluYah (Psalm 115:18). Amen and amen (Psalm 89:53).

Let my heart be perfect in Your statutes, in order that I may not be put to shame (Psalm 119:80). YHVH our Elohim be with us, as He was with our fathers; let Him not leave us, nor forsake us; that He may incline our hearts to Him, to walk in all his ways, and to keep His commandments, and His statutes, and His ordinances, which He commanded our fathers. And let these my words, with which I have made supplication before YHVH, be near to YHVH or Elohim day and night, that He maintain the cause of His servant, and the cause of His people Israel, as every day shall require; that all peoples of the earth may know that YHVH, He is Elohim; there is none else (1 Kings 8:57-60). YHVH, He is Elohim; YHVH, He is Elohim (1 King 18:39). YHVH, He is Elohim in heaven above and upon the earth beneath; there is none else (Deuteronomy 4:39). He is YHVH our Elohim; His judgments are in all the earth (Psalm 105:7).

To YHVH our Elohim belong compassion and forgiveness; for we have rebelled against Him (Daniel 9:9). For we do not present our supplications before You because of our righteousness, but because of Your great compassions. O YHVH, hear; O YHVH, forgive; O YHVH, attend and do, delay not; for Your own sake, O my Elohim, because Your name is called upon Your city and Your people (Daniel 9:18-19). Turn from Your fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against Your people (Exodus 32:12). Return for Your servants' sake, the tribes of Your inheritance (Isaiah 63:17). Turn us to You, O YHVH, and we shall be turned; renew our days as of old (Lamentations 5:21). And pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for Your inheritance (Exodus 34:9). Blessed be YHVH for evermore. Amen and amen (Psalm 89:53).

Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of Elohim our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. For there is one Elohim and one Mediator between Elohim and men, the Man Messiah Yeshua, who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time, for which I was appointed a preacher and an apostle—I am speaking the truth in Messiah and not lying—a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth. I desire therefore that the men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting (1 Timothy 2:1-8).

Great peace have those who love Your law,
And nothing causes them to stumble (Psalm 119:165).

One who turns away his ear from hearing the law,
Even his prayer is an abomination (Proverbs 28:9).

I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made;
Marvelous are Your works,
And that my soul knows very well (Psalm 139:14).

He sent His word and healed them,
And delivered them from their destructions (Psalm 107:20).

So Moses cried out to YHVH, saying, “Please heal her, O God, I pray!”
(Numbers 12:13)

Pray for the peace of Jerusalem:
May they prosper who love you (Psalm 122:6).

Do not be wise in your own eyes;
Fear YHVH and depart from evil.
It will be health to your flesh,
And strength to your bones (Proverbs 3:7-8).

Is this not the fast that I have chosen:
To loose the bonds of wickedness,
To undo the heavy burdens,
To let the oppressed go free,
And that you break every yoke?
Is it not to share your bread with the hungry,
And that you bring to your house the poor who are cast out;
When you see the naked, that you cover him,
And not hide yourself from your own flesh?
Then your light shall break forth like the morning,
Your healing shall spring forth speedily,
And your righteousness shall go before you;
The glory of YHVH shall be your rear guard.
Then you shall call, and YHVH will answer;
You shall cry, and He will say, ‘Here I am’ (Isaiah 58:6-9).

Therefore Eli said to Samuel, “Go, lie down; and it shall be, if He calls you, that you must say, ‘Speak, YHVH, for Your servant hears’” (1 Samuel 3:9).

Do good in Your favor to Zion; build the walls of Jerusalem (Psalm 51:20). YHVH builds up Jerusalem; He gathers together the dispersed of Israel (Psalm 147:2). Peace, peace, to him that is far off and to him that is near, says YHVH who creates the fruit of the lips; and I will heal him (Isaiah 57:19). Dominion and fear are with Him; He makes peace in His high places (Job 25:2). YHVH will give strength to His people; YHVH will bless His people with peace (Psalm 29:11). Blessed be YHVH for evermore. Amen and amen (Psalm 89:53).

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to Elohim; and the peace of Elohim, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Messiah Yeshua (Philippians 4:6-7).

Our Father in heaven, May Your Name be sanctified. Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us the debt of our sins as we forgive the debt of those who sin against us. Bring us not into temptation, but deliver us from the Evil One, for Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory, forever,

Amen.
